

- 1. This form can only be used when a vessel was built in its entirety (including hull) by applicant for applicant's use.
- 2. This form and clear photographs of the completed vessel must be submitted with the DNR Form B-240.
- 3. Receipts and/or invoices for all materials used must accompany the application. If these documents are not available, vessel value will be established using Department guidelines.
- 4. A 12-character hull identification number will be assigned by the Department of Natural Resources.
- 5. U.S. Coast Guard regulations (33 CFR §181.29) require that each hull identification number be carved, burned, stamped or embossed on the outboard side of the transom in such a way that alteration, removal or replacement would be obvious and evident.
