

## How to Renew Your Vessel Registration with The Department of Natural Resources COMPASS System

This Guide will help you renew your Maryland Vessel Registration, with easy-to-follow, step-by-step instructions.

If your only need is to renew your vessel registration, we offer a new and expedited path for eligible vessels. You will not have to Log-in to complete this transaction.

So, if you do not need to purchase any additional items such as a sport fishing license or angler registration, then you're in the right place.

Make sure you have your Vessel Number and your Hull Identification Number (HIN) available. You will need both to complete your Vessel Registration Renewal.

To be eligible to renew your vessel registration online or through the MVA Kiosk, your vessel record must meet the following criteria:

- Be within the renewal time period
- Has an active status
- Previously completed a transaction for same vessel within the last 2 years
- No restrictions noted on your vessel record, or customer record
- Customer record must be complete with valid mailing address
- Vessel record must be complete with all required information



You do not need to Login to COMPASS or Enroll in COMPASS to Renew Your Vessel Registration only.

Click on either the Renew Vessel Registration icon or on the Renew Your Vessel Registration in the box in the bottom row, as indicated here.



Enter your vessel number and only the last 4 digits of your Hull Identification Number. (\* Both are Required)

Click on Continue to proceed to the next step.
