

Need help reporting your discarded/released fish?

Step 1. After reporting harvest of a species, scroll back up and select "Add New Species".

Step 2. Add a second entry of the same species and fill in the required details. Note that a "Discard Reason:" is not required for undersized fish.

Step 3. Add a third entry ("Add New Species") if different sizes of fish (Legal and Not Legal) were released.
