
In 2021, anglers reported

Lengths of striped bass reported in 2021



84 striped bass lengths were reported in **2021**:

- 23% were harvested (average length 25.0 inches)
- 77% were released (average length 18.6 inches)

Volunteer angler survey data helps fisheries scientists to characterize the sizes of striped bass harvested or released by recreational anglers in Maryland throughout each year.
