Review of Minutes:

Minutes were already reviewed and sent into the public record. Ken signed hard copy minutes.

Financial Activities:

Bernie provided a report and noted that everything balances out nicely with the account. Champ will contact LaVale Lions club about a donation that was to be sent into the board for NRCC. Ken motioned to approve the financial report and Steve seconded and the vote passed.

Urban Tree Planting Grants Fall 2023:

Katherine Phillips provided a report on 3 fall urban plantings that the board supported where a total of 62 trees were planted. Kat also explained the various grants and their differences including MDOT and MUCFC. Kat also explained more about the 5M trees program and its current status. Champ made the suggestion that in the future the board could offer to help pay for tree planting specialists to take a dendrology course at Allegany College if interested. No vote was taken.

The board also discussed upcoming urban planting opportunities for spring of 2024. Brad has a potential project at the Cumberland Shriners club which will buffer Evitts Creek. Kat also mentioned that she will likely have more projects with schools, etc.

Big Tree Logo Vote:

The board took a vote on the final logo options for the MD Big Tree Program. There was some discussion as to whether the logo would be a one-time thing for the centennial or if it would be a permanent logo going forward. Adam said he would send an email asking the question and send in the board's final vote based on the response.

Evitts Creek Steering Committee

Steve updated the board on his meeting with the city of Cumberland. There he expressed his concerns for the newly contracted consulting forester not following the management plan as it was not in the job description. He felt as if his voice was heard, and he feels better about the forest management going forward. In fact, the consultant came to the next Steering Committee meeting following the meeting with the city of Cumberland.

Liberty Tree

Francis updated the board on the status of the Liberty Tree program. He stated that the nursery had approximately 100 seedlings that germinated and would be available for spring 2024, pending survival over winter. He also said that interest is very high, and he had a backlog list of over 400 people nationwide. He recently received a request for a Liberty Tree from someone in California. Brad and Francis also discussed two recent liberty tree planting events which they assisted with. Brad at the newly renovated LaVale library, which Francis also assisted with. And Francis talked about a liberty tree planting at Kitzmiller botanical garden recognizing 75 years.

There was also some discussion about raising the price of the liberty trees up from \$20. A variety of numbers were discussed and ultimately the board decided it would be Francis's final call. It seems like he plans to raise the price up to \$30 per seedling.

Francis will be collecting seed from the liberty tree in the coming weeks with help from Davey tree care lift truck. In the future, he would like to explore the idea of grafting and/or cloning as an option to provide liberty tree seedlings.

National Road Tree Cookie / 250th celebration tree

Francis asked if the board would be interested in attending an Arbor Day event at the LaVale library where a national road tree cookie dating more than 300 years old is to be dedicated and a liberty tree will be planted. He also told us he acquired another national road tree cookie dating more than 300 years old and is working with Allegany College forestry program to preserve it.

Francis also presented to the group on the idea of designating a county tree that is at least 250 years old to be celebrated in 2026 as part of the semiquincentennial celebration of our nation. Two trees were mentioned as possible options, and one was selected as the likely choice. The plan is to also

collect acorns in order to grow seedlings from the special tree. It is a large white oak growing along the national road in LaVale, MD.

Statewide Meeting update:

Adam and Steve provided an update from the statewide meeting to the board. Among the updates were the 5M tree program, the state of the MD Forest Service and staff, as well as carbon.

All renewal applications were submitted as well as a new member application for Annie Stark. There was also discussion about electing a vice chair which will occur in January's meeting.
