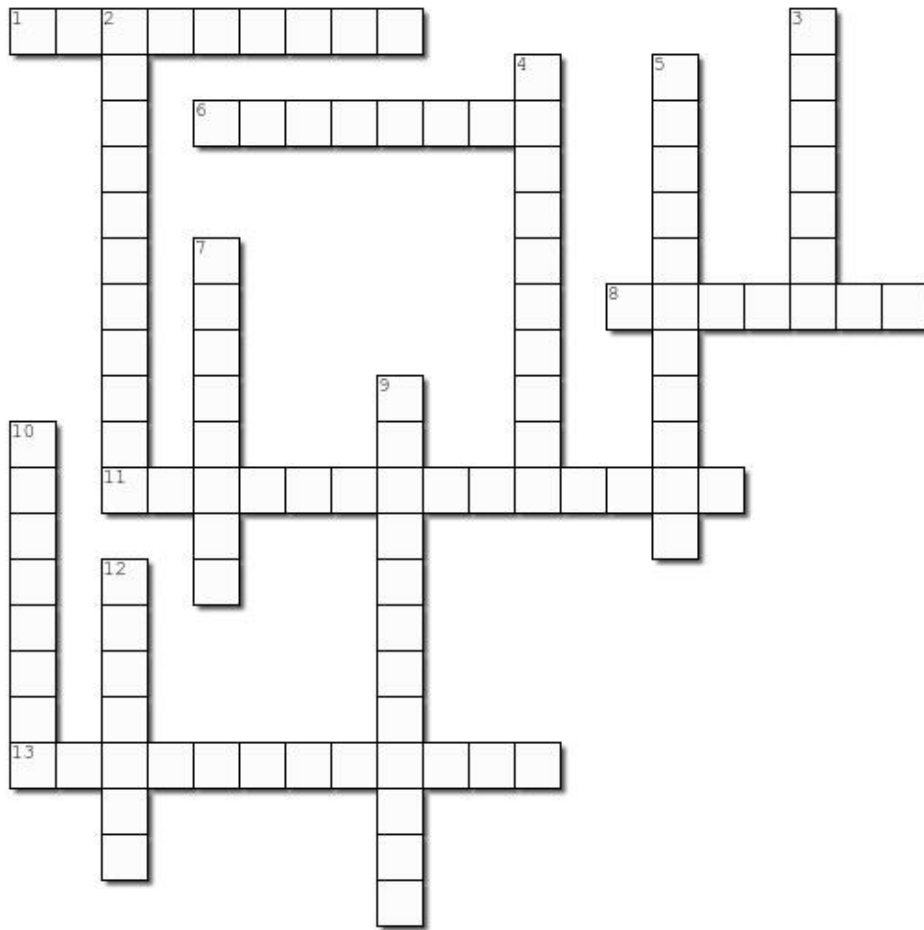

1. First discovered in Maryland in 2002. Usually tan to black in color, with 1 dorsal fin extending the length of its body.
6. Elongated green-blue body with a silver belly. Forked light green tail fin. Also has very sharp teeth.
8. Reddish bronze in color, with white belly and distinct eye-spot near the tail. Part of its name is also an instrument.
11. Olive green to greenish gray in color, with a large upper jaw.
13. Blueish green or yellow green depending on type of water. Has a pink streak on its side with small black spots.

2. Olive green to brown in color with a slender snake like body.
3. Silver body with a pinkish hue and brassy white belly. Makes a croaking sound when distressed.
4. 7-10 inches in length. Silvery greenish color body with faint black lines on each side. Highly domed gray or black back.
5. 6-9 Horizontal stripes on each side. White or silver belly. Is also the state fish of Maryland.
7. Blueish to olive green body color with bright blue claws. Also a top creature Maryland is known for.
9. Dark gray or green back with silvery white belly. Has distinct round spots on its back and fins.
10. Both of its eyes appear on the same side.
12. Blueish to brown in color. Its name may sounds like a type of pet.
