Take turns completing the tasks to earn your mark- the first to get three in a row is the winner! If you're playing on your own, try to get all four corners! You can even play more than once! **Good luck and have fun!**

Shhhhh!!!

Be very quiet... Stop and **LISTEN** to the sounds of Nature for at least **ONE MINUTE** (60 seconds). How many different sounds did you hear?

Look all around!

Find a place where a **FISH** may live and **GO THERE!** What does a fish need to survive?

Let's BUG OUT!



Take a close look to see if you can find any **INSECTS**. Roll over a log or search in a garden of flowers. Name one (or more) insect(s) you found.

Find a TREE!

Feel the bark of a **TREE**. How does it feel? Note one thing that makes it different from the other trees nearby.



Who goes there?

Look for **ANIMAL TRACKS** in the sand or mud. What animal do you think made them?



Look closely!



Find something that has a **SEED** inside of it- maybe a pinecone or an acorn? Describe what you found.

Un-be-LEAF-able!!

Find three different **LEAVES**. What shapes do these leaves remind you of?

Look up high in the SKY!

Do you see any clouds in the **SKY**? Is there anything else in the sky? What is the weather like today?

I spy...

Look for a **BIRD**. A bird has a beak, wings and feathers. What colors are the feathers?
