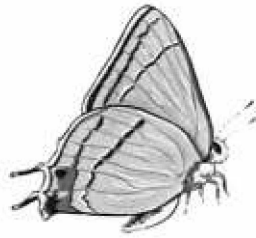


# Pollinator Playgrounds

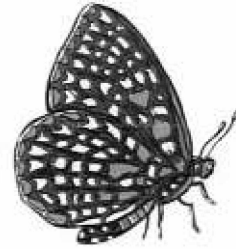

**C. Baltimore Checkerspot**



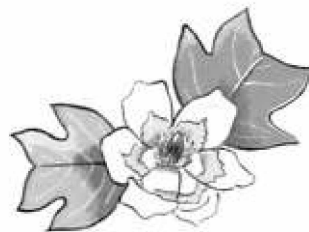
**D. Eastern Tiger Swallowtail**
