Methodology

- Survey topics developed by WHS working group.
- Survey designed and implemented by Responsive Management.
- Used 2019-2020 hunting license database.
- Hunters randomly selected.
- 3 modes of contact (email, phone and mail) to ensure maximum opportunity to include each hunter.

Survey Topics

- Hunting participation and hunter characteristics.
- Use and satisfaction with WMA hunting.
- Opinions on Sunday hunting.
- Opinions on hunter recruitment.


Survey Sample

- 24,011 hunters randomly selected.
- 5,709 completed surveys.
- 24% response rate.
- Sampling error, 1.3% at 95% confidence level for questions involving all hunters.




Hunter Demographics


- 95% male, 5% female

Where do hunters hunt?




What Species Do Hunters Hunt and How Often?




- Average number of days hunted – 29.5 days

- Small game 8.7 days








Why Don't You Hunt Small Game?






Use of Waterfowl Outfitters






Use of Outfitters for Species Other Than Waterfowl










Satisfaction With Hunting On WMAs









Use of Electronic Maps On WMAs







